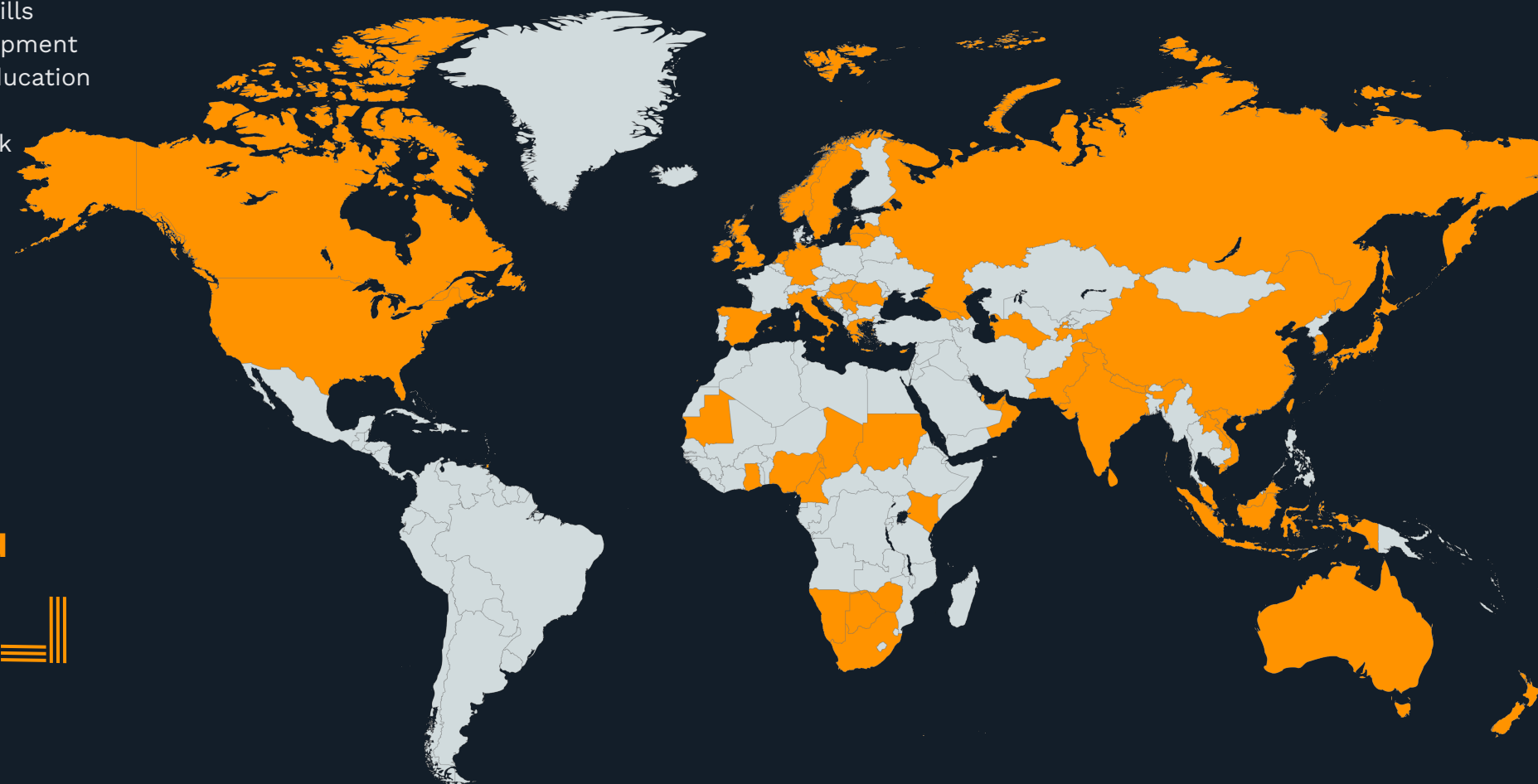
About Us

In the United Kingdom, awarding bodies are regulated by national regulators, including Ofqual in England, with qualifications listed on the official Register of Regulated Qualifications. This regulatory framework protects learners, assures employers and gives governments, institutions and training providers confidence that qualifications are valid, reliable and internationally recognised.
